Sub: Aided Colleges-Promotion of Junior Lecturers in the Private Colleges under the same management-Certain further clarification-Issued.

In continuation of the orders issued in the reference 1st and 2nd cited the following further instructions are issued in the matter.

1. Promotion of Junior Lecturers in Colleges under the same management, but having different Governing bodies.

The Junior Lecturers working in the colleges under the same management or under the same private body shall be considered for promotion even though the Governing bodies are different.

2. Order of priority for promotion of Lecturers working in degree and Junior colleges.

The vacancies of lecturers arising in the private colleges shall be filled up with Junior Lecturers in the following order of priority.

1. Junior Lecturers working in the same Degree college.

2. Junior Lecturers working in the other degree and Junior Colleges under the same management depending on the length of service put in by them in their respective colleges.

3. Length of service for promotion of Junior Lecturers as Lecturers:-

There shall be at least three years of continuous service as a Junior Lecturer for promotion to the cadre of lecturer under the same management.
