ORDER

Government of Andhra Pradesh announced its new Sports Policy in the reference cited above. The Policy aimed to popularise the sports and encourage talented sports persons through a well-laid out strategy. By such promotional measures, the Policy aimed to broad base the Sports for Youth whether in rural areas or Urban, in Schools or in colleges and to encourage the talented ones among them by admitting in sports Schools and Sports Academies and sending them for participation in higher level of competitions.

In furtherance of the objectives of the Sports Policy Sports Authority had already announced the Kreedasikshana the training programme wherein coaching programme is announced in 10 disciplines in each district. In addition to the above, with a view to encourage talented sports persons to take up sports as a career, Sports Authority announces the new Sports Scholarship Scheme **Kreedasikshana Naipunyam** from September 2000 onwards.

1. **Selection of Disciplines**

Under the Kreedasikshana Scheme, each district will select 10 disciplines keeping in view the popularity of the Game, possibility of getting Medals in International area for coaching. For this purpose,

District Sports Authorities also identify suitable senior players as coaches.

This scheme is operational only in those selected disciplines where training is taken up by DSA under the Kreedha Sikshana Programme.

2. Number of Scholarships for each District

It is proposed to give scholarships to three (3) identified sports persons in each discipline in not exceeding 10 disciplines totalling 30 Nos. per each district.

Each scholarship carries a monthly allowance of Rs. 100/- and a certificate at the end of the year.

Scholarship is valid only for a period of 12 months.

Cash Awards in each discipline will be in the following age categories.

- a) Under 14 years
- b) Under 17 years
- c) Above 17 years

3. Constitution of selection committee

A selection committee would be constituted with the following in each district for the purpose of selecting outstanding trainees for the scholarship scheme.

- a) Superintendent of Police as Chairman
- b) Two Nominees of District Collector and Chairman, DSA as Members
- c) District Sports Development Officer as Convener

4. **Eligibility for Scholarships**

The District level Committee will identify the suitable sports persons in the district basing on their talent and performance measured during their participation in the Inter Mandal tournaments being held in each district as a part of Combined Tournaments.

Selection shall be for a period of one year or till the next Inter-Mandal (District Level) tournaments which ever is earlier.

There will be fresh selection every year based on the performance in the District Level Combined tournaments.

On selection, the Committee will recommend their names to Sports Authority of A.P. for sanction of Scholarships.

5. **Allocation of Funds**

An amount of Rs. 8,28,000 (Rupees eight lakhs twenty eight thousand only) per annum is allocated towards this scheme @ Rs. 36,000 per annum.

All District Sports Authorities are directed to constitute the District Selection Committees on or before 15th September 2000 and take necessary steps to launch the scheme **Kreeda Naipunyam** by 4th October 2000 by identifying the talent during District Level Combined Tournaments scheduled from 28th September to 4th October 2000.

6. Financial Assistance

Financial Assistance shall be rendered subject to being shared between the Union Government and the sponsoring agency State Government concerned in the ration of 75:25 in respect of the Special Category States and Hilly and Tribal Areas in the States/Uts. Incase of other areas, the Central Assistance will be in the ratio of 50:50, the Central Assistance will be limited by the ceiling indicated below against each sports infrastrucure. A list of Special Category States and Hilly Tribal Areas in other states is at Annexure – 1.

6. Sports Complexes

6.1 Financial assistance can be available for construction of two types of sports complexes as described below. The ownership and management of these complexes must vest with the State Government/ UT Administration or its agencies created for this purpose. Voluntary organisation and Schools, etc., would not be assisted for these complex.

6.2 District Sports Complexes

Most of the District headquarters may already be having some sports facilities, to which one or more of the following may be added. The Central Assistance will be 50 percent of the cost subject to a ceiling of Rs. 1.00 crore. But for special Category States/Hilly and Tribal Areas in order states, the Central assistance will be 75 percent of the cost subject to a ceiling of Rs. 1.50 crore of Central Assistance.

TRUE EXTRACT OF ACT 4 OF 1988

MANDAL SPORTS AUTHORITY

10. 1. With effect on from such date as may be notified, the Government may constitute for each Mandal a Mandal Sports Authority.
2. The Mandal Sports Authority shall consist of the following members, namely.
- a) The President of the Mandal Praja Parishad who shall be the Chairman; ex-officio.
 - b) The Mandal Revenue Officer, Ex-Officio
 - c) The Mandal Development Officer, Ex-Officio
 - d) The Assistant Executive Engineer or as the case may be the Supervisor, Panchayat Raj Department; Ex- Officio
 - e) Three members, out of whom one shall be women, to be appointed by the concerned District Collector from among the person who have proficiency in games and sports.
 - f) The physical education instructor of the Degree or Junior College at the Mandal Headquarters who shall be the member – Secretary; Ex-Officio

Provided that no member of the Mandal Authority other than an ex-officio member shall be an officer or employee of the State Government or Central Government or of any Corporation or any Industrial undertaking owned or controlled by the State Government or of any Nationalised Bank.

11. The Mandal Sports Authority shall have the following functions, namely:

12. The Member – Secretary shall be the Chief Executive of the Mandal Authority and he shall exercise the following powers and perform the following functions namely:

- 1) Implement all the programmes of the Mandal Authority
- 2) Exercise general supervision and administrative control over the office staff and field staff of the Mandal Authority and also the Physical Education teachers of all the Government Degree Colleges, Junior Colleges, High Schools in the Mandal subject to the general supervision and control of the Vice-Chairman and Managing Director of the Sports Authority.
- 3) Run the day-to-day administration of the Mandal Authority and conduct all its financial and administration transactions.
- 4) Be the custodian of the finances of the Mandal Authority.
- 5) Work under the general supervision and administrative control of the Member-secretary of the District Authority.
- 6) Shall prepare and present the audited statements of account and utilisation certificates to Mandal Authority and to arrange to send them to the District for approval.
